(三) 為方便家長能經 whatsapp 即時接收到學校的訊息，請各位家長將學校之手提電話號碼(5 1 6 2 7 8 2 6)及各社工之直線電話號碼儲存至聯絡人通訊錄中。

(四) 書簿費：本學期書簿費及視藝材料費共三百元正，以統籌購買各項書簿及視藝材料

(包括手冊一本)。至於其他基本文具，如鉛筆、膠擦、原子筆、木顏色、間尺等仍須自備於書包內。(文具、衣物等，請以不脫色筆寫上學生姓名)。

另：中學班同學，請交本學期職前訓練材料費(科技與生活、設計與科技、資訊科技、實用技能等)一百元正。

本校代訂各科課本：普通話科訂購牛津大學出版社之「愛說普通話(第二版)」及培生教育出版集團之「說好普通話」，B 1 至 B 6 組每冊為四十八元三角，B 7 至 B 10 組每冊則為一百零一元正。

(五) 活動費：本學期免收活動費，一般課內、外活動(包括自閉生、高中生之活動費用)均由書簿費支付。

(六) 學生手冊：請填妥手冊上之學籍表，並由學生每日帶返。請留意每月學生學行報告、行事曆、時間表及家校通訊各欄，以保持密切聯繫。

(七) 校車：車費按月直接交司機。(紅1至紅4線則安排自動轉帳)

(八) 午膳飯盒：本學年學生午膳飯盒由美利飲食服務有限公司(四洲集團成員)供應，每日菜式不同並符合營養衛生的要求。價錢為每盒十九元五角。學校將每月派發訂餐表格，家長可選擇以繳費靈、支票付款或往OK、7-11、VANGO 便利店或華潤萬家超市繳費(不需繳付手續費)，詳情請參閱訂餐表格上之付款方法。

(九) 學生上體育課，必須穿運動服及白運動鞋(請勿穿着黑底或雜色運動鞋)。

(十) 學生必須準時上學，如由家長接送，必須於上午八時三十分至五十五分之間送返，放學則應於下午三時四十五分到校接回。上午八時三十分開始，本校將有教職員於校園內當值，故請勿讓學生於上午八時半前到校。家長如需提早接學生離校，應預早以手冊或來電通知校方。為免影響放學秩序及點算人數，家長須於下午三時十分前把早退學生接走。

(十一) 為免影響校車駛入或離開學校，請駕車接送學生上學之家長留意，切勿阻塞校門通道。

(十二) 延長學習年期之申請，可在學生任何學段中提出，並非只限於中六。而於每學年之十月底前提出之個案，將會列入該學年之申請個案；於十一月份或以後之申請，則會列作下一個學年之申請個案。

(十三) 有關因暴雨或颱風襲港而停課之安排如下：

- 如教育局於當天上午八時前因颱風、暴雨或其他原因，宣佈特殊／智障兒童學校停課，學校將會停課。未離家上課的學生應留在家中。然而學校將保持校舍開放，直至正常放學時間。已返抵學校的學生，學校將與家長聯絡後，作出安全合適的安排。

● 如有關停課指示於當天上午八時後發出

- 如教育局宣佈特殊／智障兒童學校停課，學生在上學途中獲悉停課，宜因應天氣、道路、斜坡或交通情況，以決定是否繼續前往學校。而學校將保持校舍開放，直至正常放學時間。已返抵學校的學生，學校將與家長聯絡後，作出安全合適的安排。

- 如教育局並無宣布特殊／智障兒童學校停課，學校將如常上課。如天氣、道路或交通情況惡劣，家長可自行決定應否讓子女上學。

- 已返校之學生會留校至正常時間放學(在特殊的情況下，教育局向學校發出緊急撤離指示者除外)；惟本校仍會留意天氣情況而作出最適切之處理。

(十四) 為預防流行性感冒在校園擴散，請家長繼續每天為子女在上學前量度體溫，並於手冊內之學生體溫記錄表作記錄，以便檢查。

(十五) 新學年開始，部分科組老師會於九月中前為學生進行學科能力評估，期間將不派發家課，敬請家長垂注。

(十六) 為方便學校更新學生校外考試(例如：樂器考試)或公開比賽成績，現鼓勵家長主動就有關事宜與相關學科老師聯絡。

(十七) 所有經由每月通告收取之費用均採自動轉帳方式，每月自 貴家長戶口中扣除。九月份應交費用，將於九月三十日經自動轉帳收取，祈為留意。  
註：【按銀行規定 貴家長必須於自動轉帳日前存入足夠款項，否則需繳付罰款。】

1. In order to strengthen communication with parents, please read the “Parents’ Handbook” and “Students’ Handbook” carefully. The details of the Handbook has also been uploaded to the school website. For any enquiries, please contact our school class teachers, social workers and discipline teachers.

3. Parents are advised to save the mobile phone number of the school (5162 7826) and the direct line of school social workers into your mobile phone’s contact list so that you could receive messages instantly from the school via whatsapp.

4. Books Fees: The total amount of Books and Arts & Craft Fees for the 1<sup>st</sup> Term is HK\$300 (including the Student Handbook). Students should prepare their own stationary such as pencil, eraser, pen, ruler, etc. Please put the student’s name on all articles with a marker pen.

For Secondary students, HK\$100 will be charged for Pre-vocational Training Fee (including Technology and Living, Information and Communication Technology and Practical Skills subjects.)

The school will help order Putonghua textbooks for students of the following classes:

- Putonghua textbook for classes B1 to B6 which costs HK\$48.30, and for classes B7 to B10 which costs HK\$101.

5. Activity Fees: General class activities and extra-curriculum activities fees (including activities for Autistic students and Senior Secondary students) are included in the Books Fees.
6. Parents should check and sign each section in the Student's handbook every day for any updates including "Parents/Teachers Correspondence", "Student's Temperature Record", Calendar and Time-table.
7. School Bus Fees: Payment should be paid directly to the bus driver monthly. (For school bus line Red 1 to 4, payment should be made via Autopay.)
8. Lunch meal: "Murray Catering Co., Ltd" will be the caterer of our school lunch for this school year. Various meals are available and HK\$19.50 will be charged for each lunch box. Menus will be distributed to students every month. Lunch fees can be paid by PPS, bank cheques, or through Circle K stores, 7-11 and VANGO stores, or Vanguard Supermarket (no additional charges needed). For the details of the payment methods, please refer to details listed in the monthly menu.
9. P.E. Lessons: Students should wear the school sports uniform and white sports shoes for P.E. Lessons (students are advised to wear non-marking sports shoes and avoid wearing multi-coloured sport shoes).
10. Students should be punctual and arrive at school between 8:30 a.m. and 8:55 a.m. Parents should come to school at 3:45 p.m. to pick up their children. There will be staff on duty in the school campus from 8:30a.m. onwards, thus students are strongly advised to come to school after 8:30 a.m.. If you have to pick up your children earlier than the expected time, please notify the school in advance by phone or by writing in the Student Handbook, and pick up your children latest by 3:10 p.m..
11. For parents who drive their children to school, please be reminded not to stop your car at the school front door and block the entrance.
12. Students of any year/grade are eligible to apply for the "Extension of Years of Study", and is not limited only to Secondary 6 students of the respective school year. Any applications submitted on or before the end of October shall be considered as an application of the current year; and any applications submitted on or after November will be considered as an application of the next school year.
13. In bad weather conditions, the school would operate according to guidelines issued by Education Bureau (EDB):
  - If the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or above, Red / Black Rainstorm Warning is issued **before 8:00a.m.**, classes will be suspended. Students are advised to stay at home. The campus will remain open until the end of school hours. For students who have already arrived school by the time, the school shall contact their parents and make suitable arrangements to ensure safety.
  - If the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or above, Red / Black Rainstorm Warning is issued **after 8:00a.m.**
    - If the EDB has announced the suspension of classes for special schools / special schools for children with intellectual disabilities, and the student is on his/her way to school, parents are advised to observe conditions of the weather, road and traffic, and decide whether or not to let the student continue travelling to school. The school will remain open until the end of school hours. For students who have already arrived school by the time, the school shall contact their parents and make suitable arrangements to ensure safety.
    - If the EDB has not announced the suspension of classes for special schools / special schools for children with intellectual disabilities, classes will continue. At the time of inclement weather, parents should exercise their discretion in deciding whether or not to let the student go to school.
    - Students who have already arrived school will stay in the campus until the end of school hours (except on certain special situations which require immediate evacuation upon EDB's instruction).

The school shall pay close attention to changes of the weather condition and make proper arrangements.

14. To prevent the spread of influenza in school, Parents/Guardians please measure and record the body temperature of your child on the Student's Handbook every day before sending him/her to school.
15. Assessments of student's academic abilities will be carried out for certain subjects during the first and second week. Please note that no homework would be distributed during this period.
16. Parents are encouraged to contact the respective subject teachers for updates of the students' performances in external examinations (For instance: musical instruments exams) and open competitions.
17. All payments shown in the "**Monthly Circular**" will be charged via Auto-pay. Fees for September 2019 will be charged on 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2019. 【Please be reminded that a penalty fee might be charged by the bank if there is not enough money in your bank account.】
